### ***Arrival- Sunday September 12<sup>th</sup>***

As everyone is arriving at various times on the Sunday, anyone that has arrived by 5:00pm, please join us at “My Cousin Vinnies” for dinner, followed by a trip down to the Horseshoe and American Falls via the Incline Railway. My Cousin Vinnies is directly across the parking lot from our hotel entrance (is considered adjoined to the hotel).

9:45am – Meet in hotel lobby.

10:00am- Applebee’s Fallsview for Breakfast (120 yards from our hotel)

Noon- Meet back in hotel lobby

12:15pm- departure time for Winery Tour from our Hotel via Niagara Falls Adventures

### ***Tuesday September 14<sup>th</sup>***

5pm- Dinner at Tony Roma’s Fallsview (120 yards from our hotel)

7:15pm- Leave for Ghost Walk (Car Pool)

8:00pm- Ghost Walk at Old Fort George in Niagara-on-the-Lake

### ***Wednesday September 15<sup>th</sup>***

Arrangement of meet place for dinner within the hotel area or Bingo Hall area, for those attending the Bingo on Wednesday night. Bingo starts at 6:45pm, and there will be two sessions.

Upon return from Winery Tour, nothing is scheduled, free time to do as everyone pleases whether it is the Casino or Clifton Hill. There are a few of us that do plan on heading to Red Lobster for dinner, and anyone is welcome to join us.

Recommended purchase of the “Niagara & Great Gorge Adventure Pass” for use on both Tuesday and Wednesday. This can be purchased directly at our hotel for \$39.95 or you can pre-purchase it online via <http://www.niagaraparks.com/plan/buy-tickets-packages.html> and just click on “Buy Now”, and is printable at home. The Niagara Adventure Pass covers the cost of the People Mover Bus, the Maid of the Mist, Journey Behind the Falls, Niagara’s Fury and The White Water Walk. For those not interested in the Adventure Pass, you can still purchase a “Ride all Day” voucher for the People Mover, but you will need to purchase this at the Incline Railway on our way down to the Falls. Cost of the Ride All Day voucher is \$7.62. The People Mover is the best way to get around Niagara Falls.

Not scheduled, but to discuss upon arrival, a trip to Old Fort Erie and the Chippewa Battlefield during the day on Tuesday or Wednesday.

I’ve left free time every day as I have always found that people appreciate the ability to do as they please for part of the Bash, and not be on a tight time frame. My hotel room is available each evening for everyone to get together and discuss what they would like to do with their free time, and see who would like to join them. I can also assist with computer look-up’s for pricing, and directional help.
